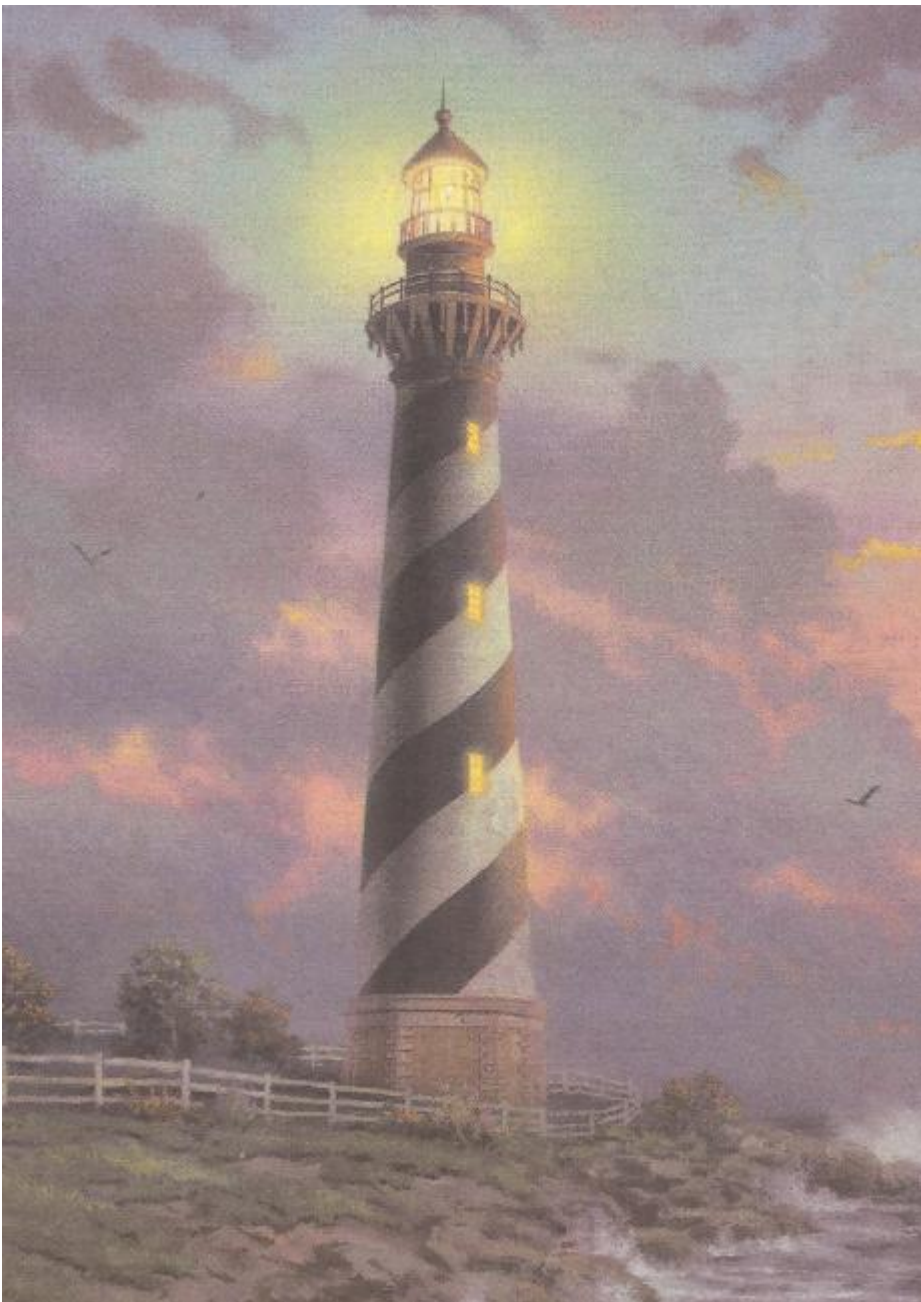


## George Wade Pitsenbarger
