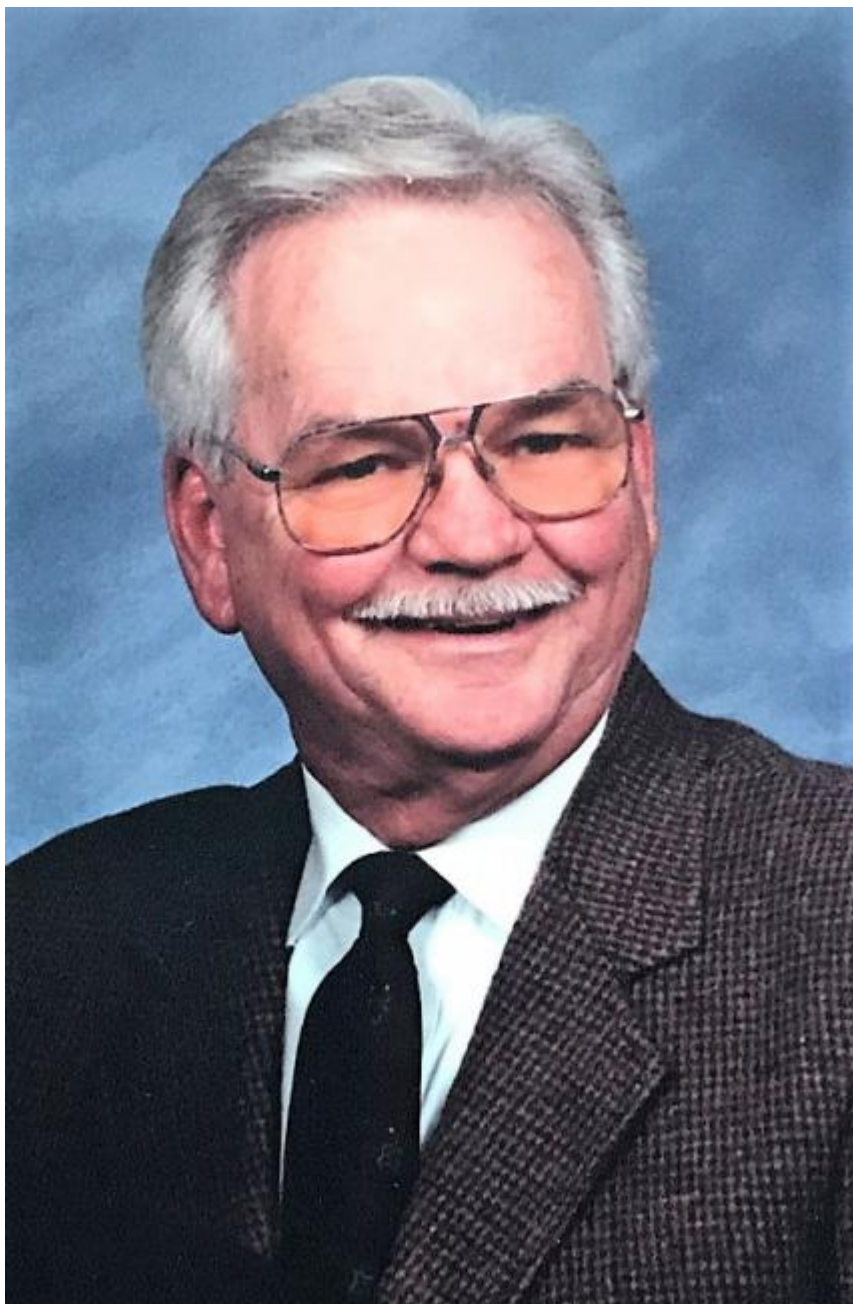


Shirley Lee "Mac" McGary
