He was stationed throughout the world in various assignments, most notably serving as an Infantry Squad Leader, Platoon Sergeant, and Weapons & Tactics Instructor. Upon retirement from the Army, he continued to serve the Department of Defense by working as a defense contractor supporting the United States Joint Forces Command Joint Warfighting Center and the Joint Staff J7 as a training modeling and simulations subject matter expert.
